The staff use the gate to the side of the front door which takes them round to the back door which enables them to enter the home. Plan to manage/mitigate the risk:			
Michael has a camera located near the side of the house, this enables him to see via a monitor who is coming into the home. Michael is sent a picture of the staff member who is coming on the day and the time that they will be coming so that he is able to watch the monitor for them. Michael will also be given an exact time that they will be coming to the home so that he is aware of when to look out for them. Should staff be running late then this should be communicated to Michael at the earliest opportunity.
